

## Australian Competition Tribunal Determination in respect of Robe Railway

Aquila Resources Limited (ASX:AQA “the Company” or “Aquila”) advises that the Company is reviewing the determination of the Australian Competition Tribunal published on 30 June 2010, in respect of the Robe rail infrastructure.

The determination was to the effect that the decision of the Treasurer made on 27 October 2008 to declare the Robe Railway and associated infrastructure pursuant to S44H of the Trade Practices Act 1974 (Cwlth), be varied, so that the period of the declaration commences on 19 November 2008 and expires on 19 November 2018.

This decision by the Tribunal may provide an opportunity for the West Pilbara Iron Ore Project to defer capital expenditure on rail, if the Robe rail infrastructure facilities are available until 19 November 2018 and the terms of an arrangement for access (including as to costs) can be agreed with Rio Tinto Limited.

The Company notes that the decision of the Tribunal may be the subject of an appeal.

The Company will monitor the situation and its implications for the West Pilbara Iron Ore Project and keep the market informed of any developments in this regard.
