### APPENDIX 4C COMMENTARY 31 DECEMBER 2013

### Operations

The Company has completed discussions with its manufacturing partner in China, Zhejiang Tianzhen Bamboo and Wood Development Co. Ltd (TZ), and finalized a settlement which was ordered by the Chinese court of Arbitration (CIETAC). As previously advised the settlement required the transfer of the Group 25% interest in the joint venture entity in full satisfaction of all remaining amounts outstanding.

The Company continues to maintain its Patents and commercial relationships and is working to develop opportunities to deliver value from these assets. In this regard, the Company will continue to progress discussions with the groups that have shown interest in potential commercialization collaborations. The Board remains optimistic that they will be able to report on progress to shareholders in the near term.

The Board continues to consider a number of other commercial opportunities and will update shareholders once a decision is reached.

### **Quarterly Financials**

During the quarter there was a net cash outflow from operating activities of \$74K. The Company had \$1,339k in cash at the end of the quarter.
