**Transpacific services return to normal**

Transpacific Industries this morning announced that all waste collection services have returned to normal, following the company's decision on 19 August 2014 to ground its heavy vehicle fleet nationally after one of its trucks was involved in a fatal traffic accident in South Australia.

Transpacific CEO Robert Boucher said: "We have worked hard to return our fleet to operation, clear the backlog and get back to normal services as quickly as possible. Our customers and the broader community have been very supportive and I would like to thank them for their ongoing patience over this period."
