



## Leonora Operations Update

The Company's FY15 production guidance for Leonora Operations (comprising the Gwalia and King of the Hills mines) allows for shutdown maintenance of the Leonora processing plant.

Management has been monitoring the condition of the mill motor plinth and has decided to undertake a two week plant shutdown to replace the plinth during September. Mining operations will continue during the shutdown period, and ore will be stockpiled. Other planned maintenance scheduled for later in the year will be brought forward into this shutdown window to minimise overall plant downtime.

The revised maintenance schedule will impact the September 2014 quarter's production at Leonora, however, the mine schedule for the first half of FY15 remains on plan and, as previously advised, Leonora's production levels will be higher in the second half of FY15.

Leonora's FY15 production guidance is maintained at 180,000 to 200,000 ounces of gold for Gwalia, and 60,000 to 70,000 ounces of gold for King of the Hills.
