## **ABT's Trailer Brake Trial Confirms Tenfold Improvement In Performance**

Advanced Braking Technology Ltd (ASX: ABV) ('ABT' or 'the Company') is pleased to provide an update on its trial of the SIBS® trailer brake with Linfox, Australia's largest privately owned logistics company. Installed on Linfox trailer dollies and operating in the Pilbara region of Western Australia, the SIBS® trailer brake trial has now run for over 90,000km and been the subject of a recent detailed inspection and testing program.

ABT is pleased to report the SIBS® trailer brake has met or exceeded expectations in every respect. Significantly, the Company has found that the brake will meet or exceed its projected 250,000km usage target, before requiring any substantial maintenance. This compares with existing standard drum brakes that require significant maintenance every 20,000km in similarly rough road conditions.

ABT's Managing Director, Graeme Sumner commented, "We welcome this affirmation of the SIBS® trailer brake's reliability and commercial advantages through the trial with Linfox. A trailer brake that can deliver a greater than tenfold improvement in performance offers transport companies the opportunity to significantly improve their productivity."

"In addition to the reduced maintenance and increased road availability, SIBS® brakes sealed design offers greater protection against brake fires that can pose a particular hazard in the transportation of dangerous goods. The trailer brake provides not only a safe and cost efficient option to the transport industry but a safer environment for the public," he said.

ABT is now reviewing its options in relation to the commercialisation of this product including partnering relationships with potential manufacturing and distribution partners.

The SIBS® trailer brake has a significant number of patents pending globally and importantly, has patents already in place in the United States of America. The USA and Australian markets have an addressable market of over 245,000 new trailers each year and an existing fleet in excess of 2 million units.
