Triton Minerals Limited (ASX: TON, **Triton** or **Company**) is pleased to advise the formation of a strategic partnership with the engagement of Rubicon Resources Ltd (**Rubicon** or ASX: RBR) to provide key support services in Mozambique. Triton is also pleased to announce the appointment of the Company's Mozambique Project Manager, Mr Gidião Mbanze.

Triton has engaged Rubicon as its preferred Mozambique service provider to assist in key aspects of the development and operational phases of its three Mozambique graphite projects (*Nicanda Hill, Ancuabe and Pemba Graphite Factory*).

Rubicon, through their Mozambique subsidiary PacMoz Lda (PacMoz), has been engaged to provide Triton with a broad range of in-country support services including; permitting, licencing, business administration, human resources (including recruitment, contract management, training and immigration) and legal support.
