RAMSAY'S MALAYSIAN AFFILIATE SIGNS NEW JOINT VENTURE IN CHINA

Further to the Company's announcement earlier today, Ramsay Sime Darby Health Care (RSD) has entered into a Framework Agreement to establish a joint venture with Jinan University No.1 Affiliated Hospital (Guangzhou Overseas Chinese Hospital).

Jinan University Hospital is an exclusive medical institution directly under the Overseas Chinese Affairs Office of the State Council of the People's Republic of China. It relies on the century old long established Chinese Jinan University, undertaking medical treatment, teaching, scientific research, health care, and product development as one of the AAA public general hospitals.

Guangzhou is a city of over 13 million people and is the capital and largest city of Guangdong province in South China which has a population of over 104 million people.

It is the intention of both parties (RSD and Guangzhou Overseas Chinese Hospital) to establish a number of high quality international hospitals in China's Pearl River Delta in collaboration with Chinese state-owned medical institutions.

The Chinese government has indicated its support for the proposed joint venture.
