Freedom Foods Group Limited Completion of Retail Entitlement Offer and Shortfall Placement

On 21st October 2015, Freedom Foods Group Limited (**Freedom Foods**) announced an accelerated pro-rata non renounceable entitlement offer of ordinary shares at an Offer Price of \$2.85 per share (**New Shares**) (**Entitlement Offer**) and an institutional placement to raise approximately \$65 million. The results of the institutional component of the Entitlement Offer were announced on 23rd October 2015 and the results of the retail component of the Entitlement Offer were announced on 11th November 2015.

Freedom has today issued 1,816,672 New Shares pursuant to the retail component of the Entitlement Offer, comprising of:

- 1,797,278 New Shares to eligible retail investors; and
- 19,394 New Shares to a nominee for the ineligible shareholders.

The total number of Freedom ordinary shares now on issue is 177,544,123.

A final Appendix 3B in respect of the issue of 1,816,672 New Shares is attached.

1,269,040 New Shares were not taken up in the Retail Entitlement Offer and were offered to, and accepted by, eligible institutional investors under a placement (**Shortfall Placement**) on Friday 13th November 2015. The New Shares under the Shortfall Placement will be issued on Wednesday 18th November 2015. Freedom will provide a separate Appendix 3B in respect of the Shortfall Placement.

The total number of Freedom ordinary shares on issue following the issue of the Shortfall Placement shares will be 178,813,163.
