

## Note 1. Statement of Significant Accounting Policies

This general purpose interim condensed financial report for the half-year ended 31 December 2015 was authorised for issue in accordance with a resolution of the directors on 26th February 2016.

Authorised Investment Fund Ltd is a company limited by shares, domiciled and incorporated in Australia. Its shares are publicly traded on the ASX.
