Partnership with Libelium

Pacific Environment Limited (ASX:PEH, "The Company") is pleased to announce that we have signed a Partnership deal with Libelium, an Internet of Things (IoT) platform provider based in Spain. Libelium designs and manufacturers hardware and software for wireless sensor networks, enabling fast, efficient delivery of IoT, M2M and Smart Cities solutions across a wide spectrum of applications.

The partnership admits Pacific Environment Limited as a member of the Libelium IoT Marketplace Partner Program, which aims to commercialise IoT kits combining Libelium's hardware with EnviroSuite technology.
