Potential Acquisitions

Since the appointment of Mr Ray Shorrocks and Mr Steve Brockhurst to the board, and David Palumbo as company secretary, the Company has reviewed a number of proposals for recapitalisation, including the potential acquisition of new assets to complement existing assets held by the Company.

The Company is aware that any acquisition may require it to re-comply with Chapters 1 & 2 of the ASX Listing Rules.

More information on recapitalisation proposals and potential acquisitions which the Company may wish to pursue will be released to the market when it becomes available.

Suspension timing and lodgement of financial accounts

The Board sought and was granted a trading halt on 15 March 2016 pending the release of an update on the Winter Garden transaction, Santa Fe matters and status of funding discussions.

The Company's shares were then suspended from trading on ASX on 16 March 2016 due to the failure by the Company to lodge its December 2015 half-yearly accounts.

On 18 March 2016, the Company, in an announcement to the ASX, noted that it was unable to lodge its half yearly accounts because it was: *"awaiting finalisation of Chapter 11 Bankruptcy in the United States in respect of Santa Fe, as previously announced, that has only occurred in the past few days which has affected the finalisation of the half yearly accounts."*

The Company further advised that it believed it would be in position to lodge its accounts: *"by early April however should resolution of this and other related funding matters then will be earlier."*

The Company understands that finalisation of Chapter 11 bankruptcy in the United States in respect of Sante Fe has been completed and the Company has begun working with its auditors to complete the audit of the Company's accounts for the period ending 31 December 2015 and 30 June 2016.

The Company advises that it received approximately USD\$212,000 (of a total pool of USD\$500,000) from the Trustee to the Unsecured Creditor trust under the Santa Fe bankruptcy proceedings. This amount was paid on a pro-rata basis to all outstanding Santa Fe unsecured creditors.

The Company retains 9,520,520 shares in Santa Fe which has recommenced trading on the OTCBB. The Company understands that Santa Fe has in recent weeks appointed a highly credentialed CEO and confirmed intentions to acquire new projects in the United States.

Updated Appendix 3B

The new management of the Company has become aware of a number of inadequate disclosures to the market in relation to recent issues of securities. These inadequacies were identified as part of the Company's audit and review process in preparation for the next phase of its development.

The Company encloses updated Appendix 3B's which details the correct number of securities on issue.




