Dear Shareholder,

On behalf of the Directors, I am pleased to invite you, as a valued Shareholder of AstiVita Limited (AIR or the Company), to participate in AIR's recently announced 1 for 1 non-renounceable entitlement offer of new AstiVita ordinary shares (New Shares) at an issue price of \$0.10 per New Share to raise approximately \$3,111,107 (Entitlement Offer). The Entitlement Offer will not be underwritten.

The issue price of \$0.10 per New Share represents a 42.8% premium to the ten-day volume-weighted average Share price (being \$0.07 as at 12 December 2016. Allotment of the New Shares issued under the Entitlement Offer will occur on 13 February 2017.

It is proposed that the funds raised from the Capital Raising will be used for the following purposes.

Restore NTA of AstiVita Limited

At the recent Audit Committee meeting in August 2016, our auditors raised concerns about AstiVita's net tangible asset position given the deferred tax asset has increased to \$3.33 million. Although AstiVita is showing signs of genuine improvement, to utilise the deferred tax asset the Company will need to generate taxable profits of sufficient magnitude that the deferred tax assets associated with carry forward tax losses can be absorbed. In light of this, the Board has taken a decision to raise capital to reduce its external borrowings by approximately \$1.9 million to restore and improve its NTA position.

2. Entitlement Offer Details

2.1 The Entitlement Offer

The Entitlement Offer is an offer to Eligible Shareholders of an estimated 31,111,071 New Shares at an Issue Price of \$0.10 per New Share, on the basis of 1 New Share for every 1 Share held (**Entitlement**), to raise approximately \$3,111,107 (before costs).

On the same date as announcing the Entitlement Offer, the Company applied to the ASX for the New Shares to be granted official quotation on the ASX. Official quotation of the New Shares is expected to occur on or about 13 February 2017.

The issue price of \$0.10 per New Share represents a 42.8% premium to the ten-day volume-weighted average Share price (being \$0.07) as at 12 December 2016.

3.1 Capital structure

3.2 Potential effects of the Entitlement Offer on Control of AstiVita

The Entitlement Offer is a pro-rata offer so that if all Eligible Shareholders take up their Entitlements and none of the Option Holders exercise their Existing Options and participate in the Entitlement Offer, the existing Voting Power of all Eligible Shareholders will remain the same.

However, if some Shareholders take up their Entitlements, Shareholders who do not take up all of their Entitlements will have their interest in AstiVita diluted.

The Company seeks to make the Entitlement Offer to all Shareholders and has extended the Entitlement Offer to Shareholders with registered addresses in the Prescribed Jurisdictions. Accordingly, if all other Shareholders take up their Entitlement, foreign Shareholders with registered addresses in the Prescribed Jurisdiction (at the date of this Offer Booklet) will not be diluted as a consequence of the Entitlement Offer, unless they elect not to take up their Entitlements.

3.3 Related Party

As a Director, Mr Lev Mizikovsky is also a substantial shareholder of AstiVita Ltd. His intention is to participate 100% in the Capital Raising. The effect of change in ownership is reflected in Section 3.5 and 3.6 of this Offer Booklet.

Mr Lev Mizikovsky and his associates currently own in excess of 50% of AstiVita at 63.13%. The increase in his shareholdings through the rights issue will see his holdings increase to 77.40% if no other shareholder takes up the offer. Please refer to Section 3.6 which describes the dilution effect of the Employee Share Scheme to be established immediately after the Entitlement Offer on Mr Mizikovsky's shareholding.

Any member who holds 75% of the issued Shares in AstiVita has the power to approve certain resolutions including:

- (a) modifying or repealing the constitution
- (b) changing the Company's name
- (c) varying and cancelling class rights
- (d) issuing bonus, partly-paid, preference and redeemable preference shares
- (e) converting ordinary shares to preference shares
- (f) approving a selective reduction or cancellation of shares
- (g) approving a selective buy-back
- (h) approving financial assistance
- (i) appointing an auditor to replace an auditor removed from office
- (j) applying for the Company to be wound up by the court
- (k) applying for the Company to be wound up voluntarily

3.6 Employee Share Scheme

Immediately following the rights issue the Board will be undertaking an issue of shares to Directors and staff under an Employee Share Scheme. Mr Mizikovsky will not be participating in this scheme. It is anticipated that if all Directors and staff take up the offer, Mr Mizikovsky's percentage would reduce to 60.89% or 74.06% (depending on the take up of each Eligible Shareholder's Rights).

Under the Corporations Act a shareholder may acquire up to 3% in any 6 month period (or if the other exceptions in s 611 of the Corporations Act apply) without the need for any regulatory or Shareholder approvals.

Therefore, notwithstanding the dilution effect of the Shares issued under the Employee Share Scheme on Mr Mizikovsky's shareholding, if following the Employee Share Scheme share issue Mr Mizikovsky and his associates hold a Relevant Interest in greater than 72% of all AstiVita Shares he will be able to reach the significant controlling position of a 75% Shareholder without the need for any regulatory or Shareholder approvals. This will give Mr Mizikovsky's the power to approve the list of matters in Section 3.5 above.
