# **Sydney Airport Traffic Performance February 2017**

Sydney Airport Managing Director and CEO Kerrie Mather said, "International passenger numbers remained robust in February with 4.2% growth, despite the Chinese New Year timing difference and the leap year effect in the prior corresponding period (pcp). Domestic traffic declined -2.5% due to the leap year effect. Domestic and international load factors continued to remain stable compared to the pcp.

"International capacity growth remains strong with an extra 220,000 international seats on a year-to-date basis. Airlines are continuing to upgauge aircraft, with Cathay Pacific announcing a third daily Boeing B777-300ER service from 29 October. Three of Cathay Pacific's four daily services will be on the larger aircraft, delivering 65,000 additional seats on the Hong Kong market."

## **Key points**

- Qantas will increase from four weekly to a daily year-round service to Bali commencing 29
   May on a Boeing B737-800, adding 35,000 seats compared to the pcp.
- Garuda Indonesia will increase from four to five weekly services to Jakarta from 30 May to 28
   October, with an additional sixth weekly service between 7 June and 26 July, adding 21,000
   seats compared to the pcp.
- XiamenAir will increase frequency on their Xiamen service from two to four weekly between 23
   June to 29 August on a Boeing B787-8, adding 8,500 seats compared to the pcp.
