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ABT completes record first quarter with \$2.6m in new orders

Advanced Braking Technology (ASX: ABV) ('ABT' or 'the Company') is pleased to announce it achieved a record first quarter ended March 2017 with \$2.6m in new orders

"This is a substantial lift in new business for the company," ABT Managing Director, Graeme Sumner said. Orders received are up 87% on the same time period last year as a consequence of improved market conditions and the company's changed strategies in product development and international market development. "Significantly, we also received 53% of Quarter One 2017 orders from international customers, which is an exciting result for us," said Mr Sumner.

In a further win for the Australian-based brake manufacturer, March 2017 also saw an order for 5 of an anticipated 28 sets of Terra Dura® Polymer Brakes from the Bouygues Lendlease Joint Venture, as part of a major construction project in Sydney. The win highlights the broader market potential of the product beyond the mining sector and illustrates the customer's commitment to cost effective safety and reliability.

"The Terra Dura® brake is ideal for those parts of the construction industry that work in rugged conditions. The combination of cost effectiveness and improved safety is proving to be of great interest to this potential group of customers," said Graeme Sumner.

"On the strength of demand experienced so far in 2017, we are confident that ABT will experience a stronger second half," said Mr Sumner. "We are looking forward to continuing to focus our efforts on the project pipeline and further strengthen our position in Financial Year 2018."
