## Sydney Airport Traffic Performance March 2017

Sydney Airport Managing Director and CEO Kerrie Mather said, “We are pleased that international passenger growth in the first quarter of 2017 has remained strong at 5.7% versus the prior corresponding period. In addition to the full year impact of services that commenced last year, over 620,000 annualised new international seats have already been announced in 2017. The additional services have been focused on Asia, with new and increased capacity to China, Vietnam, Korea, Indonesia and Hong Kong.”

The busy Easter travel period for 2016 fell in March, as compared to April this year. Domestic traffic was also impacted by some service interruptions associated with Cyclone Debbie.

### Key point

- Vietnam Airlines commenced its three-weekly Sydney to Hanoi service on 29 March 2017 on 274-seat Boeing B787-9, adding 85,000 seats annually.
