

Toll Treatment Agreement at Union Reefs Mill

Sydney, 10 May 2017: Ark Mines Limited (ASX: AHK) notes that in a press release by Kirkland Lake Gold Limited (TSX:KL) on 5 May 2017. KL states that it will suspend production at its Cosmo Mine from 30 June 2017. Production from the Cosmo Mine is being treated at the Union Reef mill. AHK was not advised of KL's proposal in respect of its Cosmo Mine prior to such press release.

AHK entered into a toll treatment agreement on 14 November 2016 with NT Mining Operations Pty Ltd (now KL) for treatment of the ore from its Mt. Porter project which is expected to commence later this quarter.

AHK is in compliance with the terms of the Toll Treatment Agreement and has no reason to expect that KL will not honour its obligations to AHK thereunder.

Negotiations with mining contractors for loading and transport of ore from AHK Mt. Porter project are currently being finalised.
