COMPLETION OF SHORTFALL

Odyssey Energy Limited ("**Odyssey**" or "**Company**") is pleased to announce that the Company has completed the placement of the previously announced shortfall by issuing 12,582,500 at an issue price of \$0.05 each under the two for one renounceable entitlement offer.

In accordance with the terms of the Shortfall Offer, the Directors have exercised their discretion to offer the shortfall securities to nominated parties.

With the shortfall now completed, the Company is in a strong financial position to progress its existing oil and gas leases and to expand its existing project base, as well as attracting new business opportunities in the oil and gas sector. In this regard, the Company will make announcements to the market as appropriate should an acquisition occur.
