HOW TO COMPLETE THIS VOTING/PROXY FORM

YOUR NAME AND ADDRESS

This is your name and address as it appears on the Company's share register. If this information is incorrect, please make the correction on this form. Shareholders sponsored by a broker should advise their broker of any changes. Please note: you cannot change ownership of your shares using this form.

METHOD A - VOTE DIRECTLY

If you mark the box in **METHOD A**, you are indicating that you wish to vote directly. Please mark either "**For**", "**Against**" or "**Abstain**" for an Item for your vote to be counted on that Item. If you vote on at least one Item but leave other Item(s) blank, the vote on the Item(s) marked will be valid but no vote will be counted or treated as being cast for the Item(s) left blank. If you mark more than one box on an Item, your vote on the Item will be invalid. If no voting instructions are given on all of the Items then the Chairman of the Meeting will be deemed to be your appointed proxy.

If you mark the boxes in both **METHOD A** and **METHOD B** then **METHOD B** is deemed to be the chosen method. The person named will be your proxy, or if no person is named, the Chairman of the Meeting will be your appointed proxy.

If you have lodged a direct vote, and then attend and vote at the Annual General Meeting, your direct vote will be cancelled. Attending the Annual General Meeting only will not invalidate your direct vote.

The Chairman's decision as to whether a direct vote is valid is conclusive.

METHOD B - APPOINT A PROXY

If you wish to appoint the Chairman of the Meeting as your proxy, mark the box in **METHOD B**. If you wish to appoint someone other than the Chairman of the Meeting as your proxy, please write the name of that person or body corporate in the box provided. If you leave this section blank, or your named proxy does not attend the Annual General Meeting, the Chairman of the Meeting will be your proxy. If your named proxy attends the Annual General Meeting but does not vote on a poll on an Item in accordance with your directions, the Chairman of the Meeting will become your proxy in respect of that Item. A proxy need not be a shareholder of the Company. A proxy may be an individual or a body corporate.

VOTES ON ITEMS OF BUSINESS – PROXY APPOINTMENT

You should direct your proxy how to vote by placing a mark in one of the boxes opposite each Item of Business. All your shares will be voted in accordance with such a direction, unless you indicate only a portion of voting rights are to be voted on any Item by inserting the percentage or number of shares you wish to vote in the appropriate box or boxes. If you do not mark any of the boxes on the Items of Business, your proxy may vote, or abstain from voting, as he or she chooses. If you mark more than one box on an Item, your vote on that Item will be invalid.

APPOINTMENT OF A SECOND PROXY

If you are a shareholder entitled to cast two or more votes, you are entitled to appoint up to two persons as proxies to attend the Annual General Meeting and vote on a poll. If you wish to appoint a second proxy, an additional Voting/Proxy Form may be obtained by telephoning the Company's share registry or you may copy this form.

To appoint a second proxy you must:

- (a) on each of the first Voting/Proxy Form and the second Voting/Proxy Form, state the percentage of your voting rights or number of shares applicable to that form. If the appointments do not specify the percentage or number of votes that each proxy may exercise, each proxy may exercise half your votes. Fractions of votes will be disregarded; and
- (b) return both forms together.

SIGNING INSTRUCTIONS

You must sign this form as follows in the spaces provided:

Individual: where the holding is in one name, the holder must sign.

Joint Holding: where the holding is in more than one name, any shareholder may sign.

Power of Attorney: to sign under Power of Attorney, you must have already lodged the Power of Attorney with the registry. If you have not previously lodged this document, please attach a certified photocopy of the Power of Attorney to this form when you return it.

Companies: where the company has a Sole Director who is also the Sole Company Secretary, this form must be signed by that person. If the company (under section 204A of the *Corporations Act 2001*) does not have a Company Secretary, a Sole Director may also sign alone. Otherwise this form must be signed by a Director jointly with either another Director or a Company Secretary. Please indicate the office held by signing in the appropriate place.

CORPORATE REPRESENTATIVES
