

**13 SEPTEMBER 2019 CIMIC'S THIESS SECURES \$1.3 BILLION CURRAGH
EXTENSION**

CIMIC Group's global mining services provider, Thies, has been awarded a six-year A\$1.3 billion contract extension by Coronado Global Resources Inc to provide mining services at the Curragh Mine in Queensland, Australia.

Under the extension, Thies will continue to provide overburden removal and haulage, mining and run of mine rehandling services, equipment maintenance and pit dewatering.

Located in the metallurgical coal-rich Bowen Basin, Thies has a long record of service at the Curragh Mine, having operated at the project since 2004.
