Commentary on Appendix 4C

Australian Dairy Nutritionals Group (the **Group** or **AHF**) lodged its Appendix 4C Quarterly Cash Flow Report for the quarter ended 31 March 2020 with ASX today. The cash outflows for the Group for the quarter includes seasonal spending on farms associated with pasture renovation and seed expenditure. This expenditure is typical for our dairy farms in preparation for the wet season which typically commences April/May each year. Farm milk production (and therefore milk revenues) are also lower in this quarter due to seasonality.
