## **Service Stream Limited signs Do Not Call Register contract**

Australian telecommunications provider Service Stream Limited (ASX code: SSM) has signed a contract with the Australian Communications and Media Authority (ACMA) to build and operate the Do Not Call Register.

The Do Not Call Register, which will begin operating no later than May 2007, will allow individuals to register their home and mobile telephone numbers if they do not want to receive certain unsolicited telemarketing calls.

Service Stream was awarded the contract through a public tender process conducted late last year. A listed company on the Australian Stock Exchange, SSM is based in Melbourne and has a national workforce of 3000 people.

SSM will be responsible for building, commissioning, operating and administering the Register and handling complaints and enquiries about the Register's operation for an initial contracted term of 4 years.

Commenting on the signing of the contract, Managing Director and Chief Executive Officer Mr. Patrick Flannigan said:

"Service Stream has positioned itself as one of Australia's leading service providers in the telecommunications field and the awarding of the Register demonstrates our broad turnkey capability".

"This project is strategically important for Service Stream. It is the first significant piece of Government work we have pitched for and potentially opens a new market for our services. The project will also attract significant profile, allowing us to further tell our story – which is very compelling – to a broader range of prospective clients."

"Over the past year, Service Stream has been implementing its strategic acquisition strategy, strengthening its revenue base and building the company's profile"

SSM partnered with independently-owned marketing agency Haystac in the tender process for the delivery of all marketing communications for the project. Haystac currently manages Australian Government public education campaigns for several agencies and Departments.
