Ruralco Holdings Limited (ASX: RHL) – Suspension from Official Quotation

Description

The securities of Ruralco Holdings Limited ('RHL') will be suspended from quotation at the close of trading today, Friday, 13 September 2019, in accordance with Listing Rule 17.2, following lodgement of the Federal Court of Australia orders with the Australian Securities and Investments Commission approving the scheme of arrangement by which Agrium Australia Pty Ltd (a wholly-owned subsidiary of Nutrien Ltd and related body corporate of Landmark Operations Limited) will acquire all of the issued shares in RHL.

Ruralco Holdings Limited (ASX: RHL) – Request for suspension from trading pursuant to Listing Rule 17.2

Ruralco Holdings Limited (ACN 009 660 879) (**Ruralco**) requests that trading in Ruralco's shares on the Australian Securities Exchange (**ASX**) be suspended from the close of trading today (Friday, 13 September 2019).

For the purposes of ASX Listing Rule 17.2, Ruralco provides the following information:

- (a) the suspension is requested in order to facilitate the implementation of the scheme of arrangement in relation to the acquisition by Agrium Australia Pty Ltd (a wholly-owned subsidiary of Nutrien Ltd and related body corporate of Landmark Operations Limited) of all of the shares on issue in Ruralco, which became effective earlier today (**Scheme**);
- (b) it is expected that Ruralco's ordinary shares will be suspended from quotation until such time as Ruralco requests to be removed from the official list of ASX. The request for removal from the official list is expected to be made following implementation of the Scheme, which is expected to occur on 30 September 2019; and
- (c) Ruralco is not aware of any reason why the suspension should not be granted.

In due course, Ruralco will apply for termination of quotation of its shares on the ASX and its removal from the official list of the ASX.
